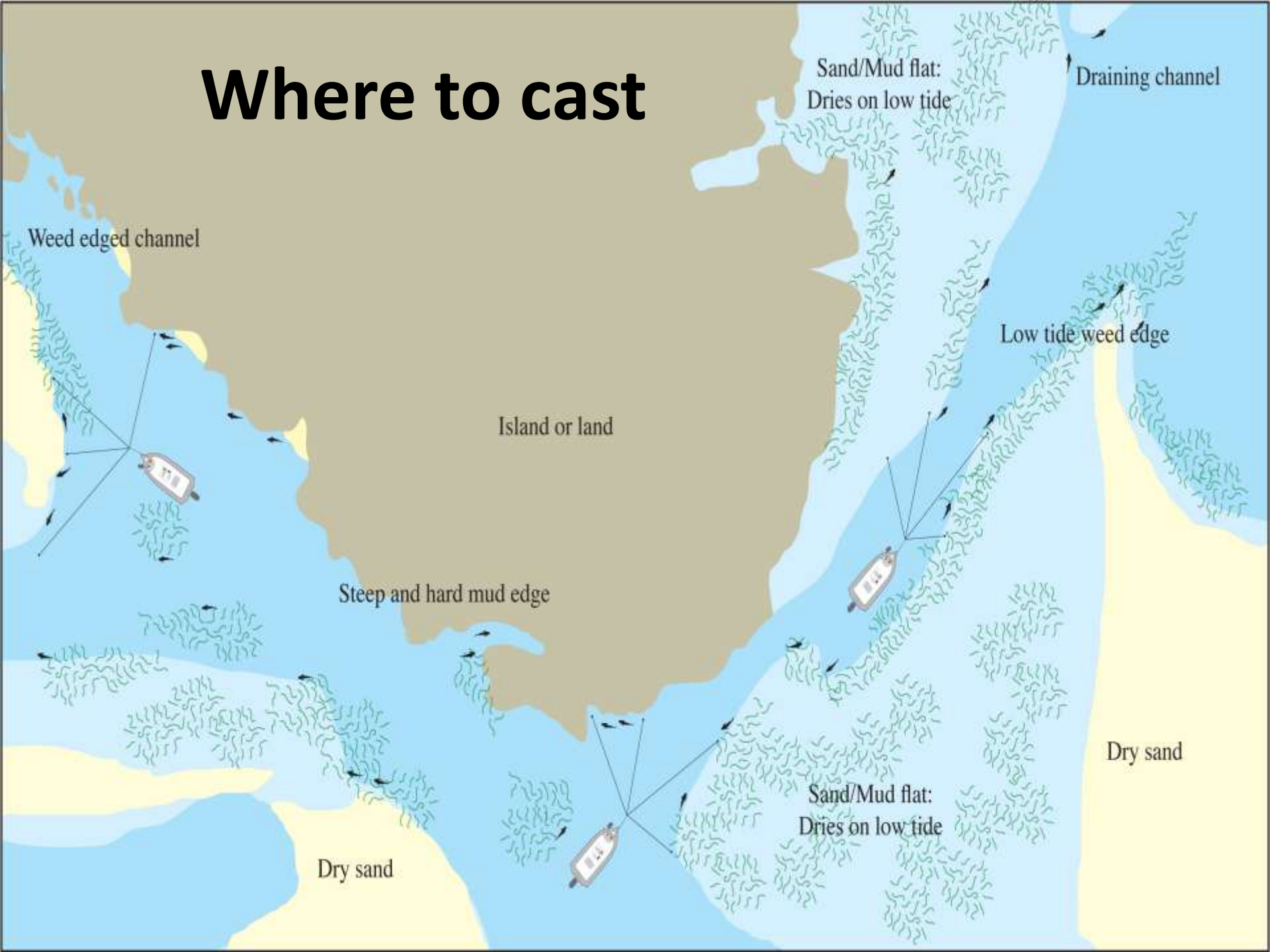
Low Tide Options

The basic retrieve



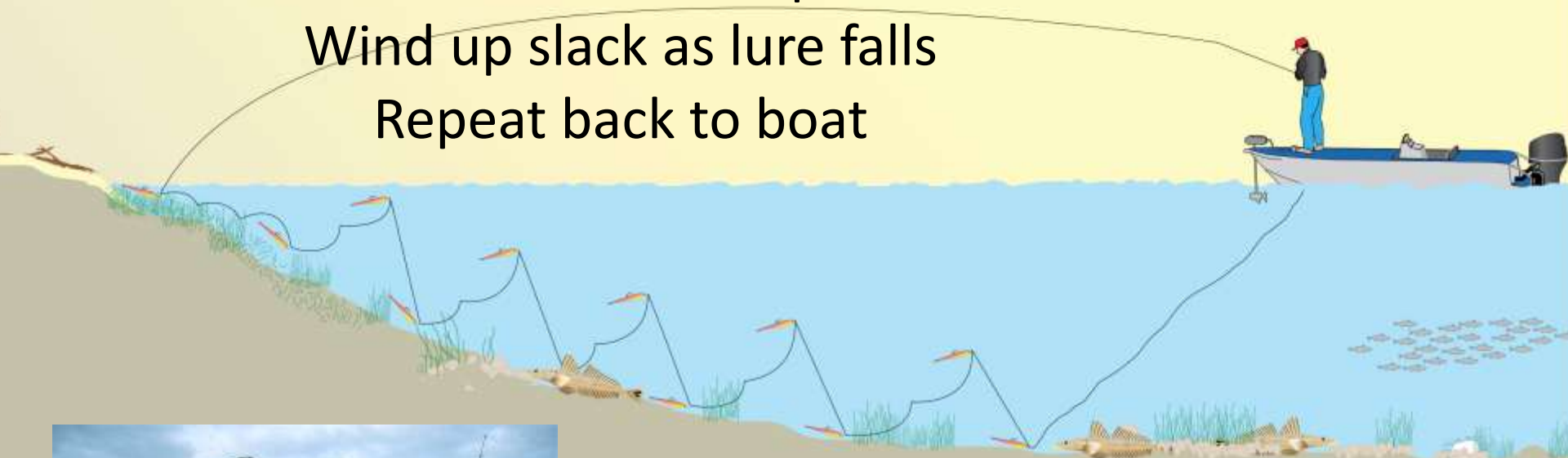
Basic Retrieve:

Cast to weeded edge

Two or three hops

Wind up slack as lure falls

Repeat back to boat





Making the Job Easier



Essential Tools include:

- Lindy Fish Handling Glove (or similar)
- Large Environet
- Minn Kota iPilot

Lindy Fish Handling Glove

Advantages:
Tooth proof,
Easy griping,
Left or right
handed,
Mostly hook and
knife proof.
